The examination shall be taken only after the completion of one of the following requirements: (1) An apprenticeship of at least 6 months with a minimum of 10 auctions, as described in Auc 302.01; or (2) Successful completion of an auctioneering school as described in Auc 302.02.
- If applicable, an apprenticeship affidavit on form as provided by the board. For an affidavit of apprenticeship to be accepted by the board under Auc 301.01(h)(1), an apprenticeship shall be served under one or more auctioneers for a period of not less than 6 months, with participation in all phases of auctioneering, as described in Auc 301.01(j) over the course of not less than 10 auctions under said auctioneers.
