6. (a) Summary of what the rule says and of any proposed amendments including whether the rule

implements a state statute for the first time:

The former Chapter Inst 500 on inspections of manufactured housing installations expired 5/15/2023 and is being renumber as Chapter Inst 600. The section is being moved in order to ensure that each Chapter, Inst 500, Inst 600, Inst, 700, and Inst 800, comply with Chapter 4, Part 1, 1.8 of the *Drafting and Procedure Manual for Administrative Rules*. The Installation Standards Board (Board) is adopting the chapter again, but containing only various expired rules from the former Part 600, with and without changes from the expired rules as described below:

- Inst 601.01, previously 502.01, provides the definition of inspector for this chapter. There have been no changes from the expired rule;
- Inst 602.01, previously 502.01, describes the inspections of installations, and the proposed rule is being modified from the expired rule to add who will conduct inspections if no local official is appointed by a city or town to complete an inspection;
- Inst 602.02, previously 502.02, describes inspections, and the proposed rule is being modified from the expired rule to change a rule citation;
- Inst 602.03, previously y 502.03, describes when inspections shall be completed and is not being modified from the expired rule;
- Inst 602.04, previously Inst 502.04, describes the correction of violations and the ability of the person to request a hearing on any violation and is being modified from the expired rule to correct the citation for Inst 209 to Plc 200 of the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) of where to find information on hearing rules;
- The former Inst 502.05, which expired 5/15/13, described fees for inspections and is not being adopted in this set of rules.

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Other proposed change are intended to improve program integrity, efficiency, and to align with current practices.

Not applicable as Inst 501.01, Inst 502.01, and Inst 502.05 expired May 15, 2023, and Inst 502.02 through Inst 502.04 expired April 14, 2022.

3. Cost and benefits of the proposed rule(s):

When compared to the expired rules the proposed rules may have a small impact to the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) Fund, State citizens and independently owned business. The proposed rules do not adopt expired rule Inst 502.05, which required a \$250 inspection fee. However, OPLC expects the removal to be de minims (under \$1,000) while they put in place a new rule under PLC 1002, which will include the \$250 inspection fee.

A. To State general or State special funds:

State general funds would not be impacted, however, the OPLC could see a de minims reduction of revenue up to \$1,000.

B. To State citizens and political subdivisions:

State citizens may see a slight savings to the extent they would be required to pay the inspection fee under the previous rule but are now in the window of time where no inspection fee would be charged.

C. To independently owned businesses:

Independently owned businesses may see a slight saving to the extent they would be required to pay the inspection fee under the previous rule but are now in the window of time where no inspection fee would be charged.
