On 6/26/2023, the New Hampshire Board of Barbering, Cosmetology, and Esthetics ("Board") reviewed an inspection report issued to you and/or your business dated 4/4/2023. The inspection report reflects 272 points assessed during this inspection. In accordance with RSA 313-A and administrative rule Bar 404 the Board shall assess fines based on the number of points a licensee has accumulated during the inspection.

The Board has determined, in accordance with RSA 313-A and Bar 400, the total number of points assessed during the 4/4/2023 inspection totals: 272 points. The Board has further assessed a fine in the amount of \$272.

You have three options upon receipt of this notice:

- 1) Pay the fine immediately, payable to "Treasurer, State of NH" no later than within 20 days of receipt of this letter.
- 2) Request, in writing, a pre-hearing.
- 3) Request, in writing, a hearing in accordance with Bar 404.07. The Board will thereafter schedule a hearing on the matter.

2. The parties further stipulate the Board has the authority to issue administrative fines for violations of statutes pursuant to NH RSA Chapter 313-A, and administrative rules PART Bar 404.
3. On 4/4/2023, a Board inspector conducted an inspection at Newbury North Salon. As a result of the inspection, the Board has issued an administrative fine in the amount of \$272 for Implements & Appliances Shall be Cleaned and Disinfected Properly x12 Stored Properly x12; No Licenses & Work Permits Displayed as Required; Providing Services with an Expired License or Work Permit x3;**(272Points)**. Respondent admits to violations contained in the inspection report dated 4/4/2023 and agrees to pay an administrative fine within 20 days of execution of this agreement.
4. The Board may consider Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions herein in any subsequent proceeding before the Board regarding Respondent's license. Respondent's breach of any terms or conditions of this *Settlement Agreement* shall constitute unprofessional conduct and shall serve as a separate and sufficient basis for further disciplinary action by the Board.
5. Except as provided herein, this Settlement Agreement shall bar the commencement of further disciplinary action by the Board based upon the violations described above. However, the Board may consider the violations as evidence of a pattern of conduct in the event that similar violations are proven against Respondent in the future.
6. This *Settlement Agreement* shall become a permanent part of the Respondent's file, which is maintained by the Board as a public document.

Further, Respondent fully understands the nature, quality, and dimensions of these rights. Respondent understands that by signing this *Settlement Agreement*, Respondent waives these rights as they pertain to the violations described herein. This *Settlement Agreement* shall take effect as an Order of The Board on the date it is signed by an authorized representative of the Board.
