Dear Jenny Nguyen :

On 6/26/2023, the New Hampshire Board of Barbering, Cosmetology, and Esthetics ("Board") reviewed an inspection report issued to you and/or your business dated 3/17/2023. The inspection report reflects 600 points assessed during this inspection. In accordance with RSA 313-A and administrative rule Bar 404 the Board shall assess fines based on the number of points a licensee has accumulated during the inspection.

The Board has determined, in accordance with RSA 313-A and Bar 400, the total number of points assessed during the 3/17/2023 inspection totals: 600 points. The Board has further assessed a fine in the amount of \$600.

You have three options upon receipt of this notice:

- 1) Pay the fine immediately, payable to "Treasurer, State of NH" no later than within 20 days of receipt of this letter.
- 2) Request, in writing, a pre-hearing.
- 3) Request, in writing, a hearing in accordance with Bar 404.07. The Board will thereafter schedule a hearing on the matter.

If you choose to 1) Pay the fine immediately, payable to "Treasurer, State of NH" no later than within 20 days of receipt of this letter: Please sign and mail in attached settlement agreement with payment.

If you fail to pay the assessed fine within 20 days of the date you signed for the notice and fail to request a hearing, the proposed fine will be final.


2. The parties further stipulate the Board has the authority to issue administrative fines for violations of statutes pursuant to NH RSA Chapter 313-A, and administrative rules PART Bar 404.
3. On 3/17/2023, a Board inspector conducted an inspection at TT Express Nails. As a result of the inspection, the Board has issued an administrative fine in the amount of \$600 for Whirlpool, Foot Spa or Spa: Cleaned & Disinfected After Each Use; Record of Cleaning & Disinfecting for Whirlpool, Foot Spa, Spa; Disinfection Container Covered at all Times; Implements & Appliances Shall be Cleaned and Disinfected Properly, Stored Properly; Creams and other Semi Solid Substances Shall be Stored Properly x3; License & Work Permits Not Displayed as Required x1;(600Points). Respondent admits to violations contained in the inspection report dated 3/17/2023 and agrees to pay an administrative fine within 20 days of execution of this agreement.
4. The Board may consider Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions herein in any subsequent proceeding before the Board regarding Respondent's license. Respondent's breach of any terms or conditions of this *Settlement Agreement* shall constitute unprofessional conduct and shall serve as a separate and sufficient basis for further disciplinary action by the Board.
5. Except as provided herein, this Settlement Agreement shall bar the commencement of further disciplinary action by the Board based upon the violations described above. However, the Board may consider the violations as evidence of a pattern of conduct in the event that similar violations are proven against Respondent in the future.

call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on Respondent's own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, and to appeal to the courts. Further, Respondent fully understands the nature, quality, and dimensions of these rights. Respondent understands that by signing this *Settlement Agreement*, Respondent waives these rights as they pertain to the violations described herein. This *Settlement Agreement* shall take effect as an Order of The Board on the date it is signed by an authorized representative of the Board.
