



Dear Licensee:

I am writing with an important update from the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) regarding CE tracking. As you know, OPLC recently partnered with CE Broker to require licensees to track their continuing education requirements through a secure portal. Utilizing a continuing education tracking solution such as CE Broker is intended to make the license renewal process more efficient, streamline the continuing education audit process, and provide a platform for continuing education instructors to offer approved courses.

While standardizing processes promotes efficiencies, OPLC recognizes that not every solution is one-size-fits-all. Many licensees have provided feedback over the last several months expressing a desire to continue to use an existing platform offered through the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy. OPLC sincerely appreciates this feedback, and has taken the opportunity to evaluate NABP's solution, the CPE Monitor. While the solution does not provide a platform for non-NABP courses to be approved, it appears to satisfy the requirements of Plc 308.04. Additionally, it is offered to all license types under the Board of Pharmacy, at no cost to the licensee. On balance, it appears to be a solution that will work for the OPLC, the Board, and Licensees.

Moving forward, Licensees may continue using CPE Monitor to track continuing education. OPLC will not be requiring licensees under the Board of Pharmacy to use CE Broker for this purpose at this time. OPLC appreciates your patience and your collaboration in this process.
