**BOARD OF BARBERING, COSMETOLOGY & ESTHETICS**  
**QUESTIONNAIRE FOR APPLICANTS AND LICENSEES**

Pursuant to Bar 301.01(b)(5), this questionnaire must be completed with your application for initial or renewal registration or licensure.

**(b)(5)a.** Have you ever been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor, **other than a traffic violation**, which has not been annulled by a court?   **YES**       **NO**

If **YES**, you must submit:

(i) A Court-provided copy of the charge(s), conviction(s), penalties imposed, and a statement created by the applicant relative to the charges;

(ii) If you are currently on probation, the probation officer's name, mailing address, and telephone number, a letter from the probation officer stating that you are in compliance; and

(iii) If you have completed probation or parole, a letter indicating you have met all the requirements and is no longer on parole or probation.

OPTIONAL: If you already submitted the above to the Board in a prior application, you may request that the Board rely on information and documents previously submitted by checking here:

**(b)(5)b.** Are you addicted to the use of alcohol or other habit-forming drugs to a degree rendering you unfit to practice under RSA 313-A?       **YES**       **NO**
