On January 24, 2022 the New Hampshire Board of Barbering, Cosmetology, and Esthetics ("Board") reviewed an inspection report issued to you and/or your business dated October 13th, 2021. The inspection report reflects 150 points assessed during this inspection. In accordance with RSA 313-A and administrative rule Bar 404 the Board shall assess fines based on the number of points a licensee has accumulated during the inspection.

The Board has determined, in accordance with RSA 313-A and Bar 400, the total number of points assessed during the October 13th, 2021, inspection totals: 150 points. The Board has further assessed a fine in the amount of \$150.00.

You have three options upon receipt of this notice:

- 1)Pay the fine immediately, payable to "Treasurer, State of NH" no later than within 20 days of receipt of this letter:
- 2) Request, in writing, a pre-hearing conference in accordance with Bar 404.06;
- 3)Request, in writing, a hearing in accordance with Bar 404.07. The Board will thereafter schedule a hearing on the matter.

If you: 1) Pay the fine immediately, payable to "Treasurer, State of NH" no later than within 20 days of receipt of this letter;

Also, sign and mail in attached settlement agreement with payment.

If you fail to pay the assessed fine within 20 days of the date you signed for the notice and fail to request a hearing, the proposed fine will be final.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

In the Matter of:

Case #2021-ENF-Supercuts-1060

Supercuts License# 2153 MJJM Enterprises

In order to avoid the delay and expense of further proceedings and to promote the best interests of the public and the practice of Barbering, Cosmetology, and Esthetics, the Board of Barbering, Cosmetology, and Esthetics ("the Board") and Supercuts ("Respondent"), a licensed shop currently licensed in the State of New Hampshire, agree to resolve certain allegations of violations regulating the profession now pending before the Board in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The parties stipulate that Board inspectors have jurisdiction to conduct inspections of shops and schools pursuant to NH RSA 313-A: 21 and administrative rule Bar 404.01.is
- 2. The parties further stipulate the Board has the authority to issue administrative fines for violations of statutes pursuant to NH RSA Chapter 313-A, and administrative rules PART Bar 404.

- 3. On October 13, 2021, a Board inspector conducted an inspection of Supercuts As a result of the inspection, the Board has issued an administrative fine in the amount of \$150.00 for MSDS sheets (100 points), license and work permits displayed as required (50 points). Respondent admits to violations contained in the inspection report dated October 13th, 2021 and agreed to pay an administrative fine within 20 days of execution of this agreement.
- 4. The Board may consider Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions herein in any subsequent proceeding before the Board regarding Respondent's license. Respondent's breach of any terms or conditions of this *Settlement Agreement* shall constitute unprofessional conduct and shall serve as a separate and sufficient basis for further disciplinary action by the Board.
- 5. Except as provided herein, this Settlement Agreement shall bar the commencement of further disciplinary action by the Board based upon the violations described above. However, the Board may consider the violations as evidence of a pattern of conduct in the event that similar violations are proven against Respondent in the future.
- 6. This *Settlement Agreement* shall become a permanent part of the Respondent's file, which is maintained by the Board as a public document.
- 7. Respondent voluntarily enters into and signs this *Settlement Agreement* and states that no promises or representations have been made to Respondent other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
- 8. The Board agrees that in return for Respondent executing this *Settlement Agreement*, the Board will not proceed with the formal adjudicatory process based upon the facts described herein.

- 9. Respondent understands that Respondent's action in entering into this *Settlement Agreement* is a final act and not subject to reconsideration or judicial review or appeal.
- 10. Respondent has had the opportunity to seek and obtain the advice of an attorney of Respondent's choosing in connection with Respondent's decision to enter into this *Settlement Agreement*.
- Respondent understands that the Board must review and accept the terms of this Settlement Agreement. If the Board rejects any portion, the entire Settlement Agreement shall be null and void. Respondent specifically waives any claims that any disclosures made to the Board during its review of this Settlement Agreement has prejudiced Respondent's right to a fair and impartial hearing in the future if this Settlement Agreement is not accepted by the Board.
- Settlement Agreement. Respondent understands that Respondent has the right to a formal adjudicatory hearing concerning this matter and that at said hearing Respondent would possess the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on Respondent's own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, and to appeal to the courts. Further, Respondent fully understands the nature, quality and dimensions of these rights. Respondent understands that by signing this Settlement Agreement, Respondent waives these rights as they pertain to the violations described herein. This Settlement Agreement shall take effect as an Order of The Board on the date it is signed by an authorized representative of the Board.


