Renewal Checklist

Professional Board: Board of Pharmacy (Non-Resident)

Please use this checklist to prepare for your online renewal. Required items not submitted may cause delays in renewal of a license.

Required Information

- **Copy of a Facility Inspection Report**
 - Within last 18 months
 - Document compliance with New Hampshire Board of Pharmacy rules regarding sterile compounding of injectable drugs, and
 - non-sterile compounding in compliance with the United States Pharmacopoeia (USP) Chapter 797 & Chapter 795 pursuant to RSA 318:14-a-1
 - Performed by
 - * Your home state's board of pharmacy
 - * Other responsible state or national regulatory agency; or
 - * New Hampshire board of pharmacy approved third party entity
 - A signed attestation by the pharmacist-in-charge stating there is a policy and procedures manual available showing compliance with USP 795 and 797
 - If there are any 483 issues, then include
 - * A description of the issue
 - * Facility's response(s) to those 483's received
 - * A current certification inspection report completed under dynamic conditions, not at rest, within the last 6 months
- **Copy of the Pharmacy's Current Home State Pharmacy License/Permit**
- **If Shipping Controlled Substances: Copy of the Pharmacy's Current Federal DEA Permit**
- **Name, address, telephone number and Internet address, if applicable, of the pharmacy**
 - The names, corporate or business addresses and titles, of all principal corporate officers, if incorporated, or all partners or owners of the pharmacy if not incorporated
- **Response to Questions:**
 - Please read each question carefully.
 - If you answered "Yes" to questions #1 thru #8, must upload a detailed explanation and any applicable documentation of discipline.
- **Licensing Fee: \$2000.00**
 - Forms of payment accepted: MasterCard, VISA, AMEX and Discover
