VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE

Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the New Hampshire Board of Licensing for Alcohol and Other Drug Use Professionals ("Board"), I, Wendita M. Schumacher, LADC, hereby voluntarily surrender my New Hampshire license (#0918) effective on the date that the Board accepts this offer of voluntary surrender.

By voluntarily surrendering my license, I understand that:

1. I relinquish all rights and privileges to practice as a licensed alcohol and drug counselor in the State of New Hampshire effective upon the Board's acceptance of this voluntary surrender.
2. I admit that this voluntary surrender of license is occurring following the completion of a Board investigation conducted pursuant to RSA 330-C:28, and to resolve the pending misconduct allegations that I:
 - a. Provided incorrect information to a court regarding a client's ongoing sobriety; and
 - b. Failed to maintain records that met the appropriate standards for recordkeeping.


3. I admit to no violations of RSA 330-C:27, III, but recognize that the fact of my voluntary surrender will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action to all relevant licensing authorities and professional societies in the same manner as a final decision making specific finding of professional misconduct. I further understand that this document shall become a permanent part of my file, and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.
4. Should I again seek licensure in the State of New Hampshire, I must meet and shall bear the burden of proving compliance with all of the standards and prerequisites then required by the Board for new applicants, including professional character requirements.
5. I understand that the pending disciplinary allegations shall be resolved in any future licensure application I may submit in New Hampshire. I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available as to these misconduct allegations.
6. I voluntarily submit this surrender of license to the Board and state that no promises or representations have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
