

MINUTES
BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS
February 2, 2017

PUBLIC SESSION:

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners (Board) meeting was held on February 2, 2017, 121 South Fruit Street, Concord, NH. Tamara Lovelace, D.C., Chairman called the meeting to order at 8:30 A.M. Present and eligible to vote: Sofia Haffenreffer, D.C., Lisa Lanzara-Bazzani, D.C., Keith Zimmermann, D.C., and Scott MacDonald, public member.

Minutes:

On a motion by Dr. Haffenreffer, seconded by Dr. Zimmermann, the minutes of the January 5, 2017 meeting were approved as written.

The Board discussed various aspects of the existing rules but decided that the only change required was updating the fee.

Rules: Robert Lamberti, Jr., Esquire, Rules Coordinator was present to discuss a letter that all department heads received from Governor Sununu requesting that all rulemaking requests be stopped until March 31st unless the rules affect the health, safety or welfare of NH citizens. Mr. Lamberti noted that he would like to proceed with adopting interim rules since that decision had already been made at a previous meeting. He noted that if approved, these interim rules will be valid for 180 days from filing the rules with the Administrative Rules Office. He will then reach out to the Governor's Office to explain the situation.

On a motion by Dr. Zimmermann, seconded by Dr. Lanzara-Bazzani, that the chiropractic interim rules be adopted as previously discussed. Motion Adopted.

Attorney Lamberti will report back to the Board at the March meeting.

Application(s) for Licensure:

On a motion by Dr. Haffenreffer, seconded by Dr. Zimmermann, the Board voted unanimously to approve Andrew M. Cooledge, D.C. and Joel C. Penley, D.C. for licensure. Motion Adopted.

New Business:
