Order on Motion for Reconsideration/Rehearing

On June 13, 2011, the Board of Barbering Cosmetology and Esthetics ("Board") issued a Decision and Order in the adjudicatory proceeding of In the Matter of Nam Ngoc Tran.¹ On July 11, 2011, the Board received a letter from Hank H Tran.²

At its regularly scheduled monthly meeting on July 25, 2011, the Board reviewed this letter. Despite the letters failure to meet the standards required under Bar 213.01, the Board considers this letter as a Motion for Reconsideration or Rehearing.

The Board has voted to deny the motion. The Board finds that the motion does not identify any errors of fact, any errors of reasoning or any erroneous conclusions contained in the June 13, 2011 Decision and Order. See Bar 213.01 (c)(2).


THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that Hank Tran's motion to reconsider is denied.
