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DISCUSSIONS:

The Board reviewed the status of HB 82 relative to hair braiding.

The Board reviewed several rule proposals, Document #12085 for Interim rules and Notice # 2016-227 various sections of Bar 300-400. Upon the motion of HR and the second of JC, the Board voted to adopt #12085 as amended a final proposal. AIF Upon the motion of KH and the second of AL, the Board also voted to start two separate initial proposals, one for replacement of the interim rules in place Notice # 2016-227, and one to start new rulemaking relative to initial inspections, shop application, and fine amounts. The Board reviewed newspaper articles relative to deregulation.
