Ph 704.15 Prescription Refill - Interim Supply. A pharmacist may refill a prescription drug order, including controlled substances listed in Schedules III, IV and V, without the authorization of the prescribing practitioner, provided that:

(c) **Unless federal law states otherwise, t**he quantity of prescription drug dispensed does not exceed a **9030** day supply for maintenance medications;

**Readopt with amendments Ph 1303.01(b), effective 9-18-12 (Document #10185), cited and to read as follows:**

Ph 1303.01 Qualifications.

(b) A pharmacist who seeks to engage in the administration of vaccines shall hold current basic or higher certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) from the American Heart Association, the American Red Cross, or from another organization or entity that is nationally-recognized as an issuer of such certifications. **Notwithstanding, during a State of Emergency declared by the Governor, the Board shall allow pharmacists 60 days past the expiration of the State of Emergency to complete this requirement.**

**Readopt with amendments Ph 1104.01(b), effective 1-23-18 (Document #12464), cited and to read as follows:**

Ph 1104.01 Application.

(b) A pharmacist who seeks to engage in the administration of vaccines shall hold current basic or higher certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) from the American Heart Association, the American Red Cross, or from another organization or entity that is nationally recognized as an issuer of such certifications. **Notwithstanding, during a State of Emergency declared by the Governor, the Board shall allow pharmacists 60 days past the expiration of the State of Emergency to complete this requirement.**
