**CONFERENCE CALL
PUBLIC MINUTES – JANUARY 9, 2019**

Moderator and Board President Tara Levesque-Vogel, DMD, called a conference call of the New Hampshire Board of Dental Examiners to order at 12:30 p.m. with the following members participating from the locations as set forth below:

Board President Tara Levesque-Vogel, DMD found that in this instance, undelayed action was deemed to be imperative and the physical presence of a quorum was not reasonably practical within the period of time requiring action. Participating members all stated that either because of the last minute scheduling or because one or more members were out of the state, they were unable to physically attend an in-person meeting at the Board's office.

At 12:30 p.m., the Board voted, by roll call, 6-0, to go into a non-meeting with Jon Lavalley, Board Counsel.

Pursuant to RSA 91-A:3 the Board voted by roll call, 6-0, to go into non-public session at 2:30 p.m. for the purpose of discussing an investigation of alleged licensee misconduct and other confidential Board business and noting that such a non-public session is authorized by RSA 91-A:3, II(a); RSA 91-A:II(e), RSA 91-A:5, IV, RSA 330-C:28, RSA 330-C:29, Lodge v. Knowlton, 119 NH 574 (1978), and the Boards' executive and deliberative privileges.

The Board voted by roll call, 6-0, to seal the minutes of the non-public session.

The Board voted by roll call, 6-0, to come out of non-public session at 1:20 p.m.

The Board voted by roll call, 6-0, to go back into public session at 1:20 p.m. The Board voted 6-0, to issue an Order of Preliminary Agreement Not to Practice, with modifications, to be presented to the licensee.

The Board voted by roll call, 6-0, to approve Dr. Kremser's application for an unrestricted permit for moderate sedation without ACLS, as he only will treat patients under the age of 13.
