**CONFERENCE CALL  
PUBLIC MINUTES – August 3, 2017**

Moderator and Board President Tara Levesque-Vogel, DMD, called a conference call of the New Hampshire Board of Dental Examiners to order at 2:02 p.m. with the following members participating from the locations as set forth below:

Board President Tara Levesque-Vogel, DMD found that in this instance, undelayed action was deemed to be imperative and the physical presence of a quorum was not reasonably practical within the period of time requiring action. 1. Dr. Levesque-Vogel asked each participating Board member if he or she had read the following documents: Draft Order of Emergency License Suspension and Notice of Hearing; Report of Investigation of August 3, 2017; and emailed complaints from 3 employee's of Dr. Wullbrandt's. Each Board member responded in the affirmative.
2. The Board voted unanimously to issue the Order of Emergency Suspension of License and Notice of Hearing.
3. The question was raised as to the scheduled date of the Hearing and if it was within the proper timeframe. Dr. Levesque-Vogel stated that this was asked of APU and APU affirmed that an emergency action pursuant to RSA 317-A:18-b requires a hearing to be scheduled within 30 days.
