**CONFERENCE CALL
PUBLIC MINUTES – March 28, 2018**

Board President Tara Levesque-Vogel, DMD called the conference call meeting to order at 9:35 a.m. The Board found that in this instance, undelayed action was deemed to be imperative and the physical presence of a quorum was not reasonably practical within the period of time requiring action. Participating members all stated that because of the last minute scheduling, they were unable to physically attend an in-person meeting at the Board's office.

At 9:36 a.m. and pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, the Board voted by roll call, 5-0, to go into non-public session for the purpose of discussing an investigation of alleged licensee misconduct and other confidential Board business, and noted that such a non-public session is authorized by RSA 91-A:3, II(a), RSA 91-A:, II(e), RSA 91-A:5, IV, RSA 330-C:28, RSA 330-C:29, Lodge v. Knowlton, 119 N.H. 574 (1978), and the Board's executive and deliberative privileges.

The Board voted by roll call, 5-0, as follows:

- The Board found that that there is no longer an imminent threat;
- The Board voted to lift the license suspension of Dr. Brian Hunter;
- The Board voted to cancel the hearing in this matter currently scheduled for April 2, 2018; and
- The Board voted to further consider this issue and whether additional discipline is warranted, after receipt of CEU documentation is received from Dr. Hunter's hygienists.

The Board also voted by roll call, 5-0, to seal the minutes of the non-public session.

The Board voted by roll call, 5-0, to come out of non-public session and to take the actions as set forth above.
