▪ OLD BUSINESS

1) Acceptance of Minutes NHASEC Advisory Subcommittee Feb 21, 2018 -

Recommend table to time after review by Administrator.

2) Rules changes - Revise or Rewrite

Committee members believe that revision is most expeditious, and rewrite seems unnecessary at this time. Revision will be necessary after HB1577 is implemented. Final language awaits passage of the bill.

3) Training for members of permit holder's staff: content, length of time, names of participants

Committee members believe that a log of emergency drills should be kept. Drills should occur quarterly at the least. The log should include the content of the drill, time began and ended, and names of participants, and names of absentees. Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery National Insurance Company (OMSNIC) and American Dental Society of Anesthesiology (ADSA) have emergency drill options.

4) HB1577 to the Senate

The amended version is acceptable to the Advisory Subcommittee. The minimal sedation provisions will put an administrative burden on the Board which may be crushing.

5) Dental Anesthesia Rules Revision Plan

Awaits passage of HB1577.

6) NHBODE vacancy

We recommend consideration of Dr. Mark Scura, well-qualified due to his dedication to the safety of NH patients undergoing sedation and anesthesia in the dental office.

7) Letter of Appreciation to Dr. Kuepper

We will have the Committee members sign a card and the Chair will send a letter of appreciation for Dr. Kuepper's service to NHASEC and NHBODE.
