7. New Business –

- a.  - iv. Remove Mechanical - HVAC & Refrigeration, Mechanical – Machine Design & Materials, Mechanical – Thermal and Fluid Systems, Manufacturing, and Software from the designations
 - v. Add Mechanical to the designations
- e. Online degrees for licensure – A brief discussion was held and it was noted that the Board will accept online degrees as they would accept any traditional degree. They all must meet the same qualifications.
