

**Professional Engineers Board  
Public Minutes  
Zoom Meeting  
May 22, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.**

A meeting of the Professional Engineers Board was held May 22, 2020 via a Zoom meeting. The meeting was called to order by Chairman C. Mulleavey at 8:59 a.m. Also present were: C. Ackroyd, M.
