ADMINISTRATIVE

1. The Board held an open forum for public comment from 1:02 pm to 1:15 pm. The public made brief comments. Mike Younus spoke with the Board about RNS's being licensed and how HB 334 will effect this requirement.
2. Rules:
 - a. Mirt 100 –Fiscal Impact Statement has been received. Hearing will be scheduled for July 27, 2017.
 - b. Mirt 200 –Fiscal Impact Statement has been received. Hearing will be scheduled for July 27, 2017.
 - c. The Board provided Attorney Robert Lombardi with additional information pertinent to Mirt 300, Mirt 400, and Mirt 500. The Board will continue to work on these rules at their July meeting.
 - d. The Board reviewed RSA 332-G:7 and will take this law into consideration when writing rules.

- c. The Board reviewed a request from Peter Danles, Executive Director of OPLC to include a page dedicated to those in the military service to the application. The Board will consider the request when writing the rules.

Laws:

- a. HB 184 – Amended Title: relative to the license requirement for medical imaging and radiation therapy and relative to registration by practitioners with the board of medical imaging and radiation therapy. The bill extends the requirement for licensure and registration from 7/1/17 to 7/31/18. Signed by the Governor on 4/17/17.
- b. HB 334– relative to an exemption from licensure by the board of medical imaging and radiation therapy. This bill has been changed to allow other professionals to perform medical imaging so long as it is within their scope of practice. Enrolled in both the House and Senate.
- c. HB 322 – adding rulemaking authority to require completion of a certain survey as part of the license renewal process for health care providers. Signed by the Governor on June 16, 2017.

ADJOURN: on motion by Todd Bedard with a second by Winslow Whitten, the motion to adjourn at 2:34 P.M. carried in the affirmative.
