**QUALIFICATION AND LICENSURE**

1. **MEDICAL IMAGING AND RADIATION THERAPIST APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSURE**

The Board reviewed the application and supporting documents of Diana E. Grimes. During that review the Board noted the criminal record reports and Ms. Grimes letter explaining that both Maine and Texas submitted reports that had information that was not her background. The Board voted on a motion from Richard Serino with a second by Winslow Whitten to send Ms. Grimes a letter instructing her to contact both Maine and Texas to clear up the matter and have them provide reports that are accurate.

### ADMINISTRATIVE

2. The Board opened the Public Forum at 1:00 pm. No members of the Public were present. The Board closed the Public Forum at 1:15 pm.
3. Rules:
  - a. Rule writing on Mirt 400 has been postponed to the November meeting. The OPLC Rules attorney has resigned his position. The Board's Administrator will fill in until a new rule writing attorney can be hired by OPLC.
4. Marcy Rushford of Catholic Medical Center asked the Board if students in their last semester could work at their facility. The Board will respond that RSA 328-J:25 Exemptions VI. It states:

“A resident physician or a student enrolled in and attending a school or college of medicine, dentistry, osteopathy, chiropractic, podiatry, limited x-ray machine operator, medical imaging, or radiation therapy who performs medical imaging or radiation therapy procedures on humans while under the supervision of a licensed practitioner or a person holding a license under this chapter in the supervised modality.”
5. Heather S. Jaramillo, JD, Compliance Specialist at UNM Extended Learning asked the Board if their post-licensure radiologic science programs would be subject to any Board regulation. The Board voted on a motion from Raymond Hebert with a second by Winslow Whitten to respond that the Board does not approve post-licensure education. The individuals as described would not be required to be on any type of registry/list because they would already be licensed.
6. Angela Boivin V.P. of Northern New England Vascular Society has requested a speaker to attend their upcoming meeting to be held on November 3, 2018. The Board's Administrator and Board member Winslow Whitten, who is already attending, will present on initial licensure and answer questions.
7. The Board reviewed an e-mail sent by Michael O'Connell in which he expressed concerns about the new rules governing C-arm fluoroscopy and their implementation and provides an argument to delay implementation of those rules. The Board voted on a motion from Tammy Newell with a second by Richard Serino to respond that the Board hears his concerns and will take them under advisement.

8. The Board reviewed an e-mail submitted by Christopher Bristol, MBA, RDCS, RVS, Clinical Coordinator Echocardiography at Parkland Medical Center. Mr. Bristol asked the Board where does intravascular ultrasound (IVUS) in the Cath Lab fall in the scope of practice and are only licensed Ultrasound sonographers able to operate an IVUS in the Cath Lab? The Board voted on a motion from Winslow Whitten with a second by Raymond Hebert to request additional information before responding. The Board wishes to know who is currently doing IVUS in Parkland Medical Centers Cath Lab?

ADJOURN: on motion by Raymond Hebert with a second by Winslow Whitten, the motion to adjourn at 3:04 P.M. carried in the affirmative.
