Question #1 from Anna Johnson

Telehealth: Is it legal to use Telehealth out of state? I don't bill insurance for anything if that matters.

Answer: Telehealth services are governed by the state where the patient resides.

Question #3 from Janice Brundage

I have been seeing someone in Tucson who will be moving to New Hampshire for school. Do you have a process that I could complete so that I could continue contact with him?

Answer: A naturopathic practitioner must be licensed in New Hampshire if treating a resident.
