**The Board called this Emergency meeting to discuss the following rules;**

Ph 707.03 - **Board Authorized Controlled Drug Destruction.** On motion from Commissioner Harrington to approve with a second from Commissioner Genovese and a roll call vote of 7-0-0.

Ph 210.01 - **Substantive Waiver.** On motion from Commissioner Laliberte to approve with a second from Commissioner Harrington and a roll call vote of 7-0-0.

Ph 704.03 - **Transmission of Prescription Drug Order by Prescriber, schedule II drugs.** On motion from Commissioner Genovese to approve with a second from Commissioner Harrington and a roll call vote Of 6-0-1 Commissioner Laliberte abstained. Verifies a quorum

Chloroquine and albuterol inhalers is an FYI and is on the Board website for all to review. There is a USP suggestion on the website as well.

The process to grant waivers;

1. Waiver received in the office and place it on the grid/spreadsheet created, then
2. The waiver will go to compliance first, for their review and suggestions.
3. Then the waiver request will go to the Board Chair and the chair will include any Board member where the waiver is in their area of expertise.
4. The two Board members will review and possibly approve.
5. Once approved, the waiver will then go to the next regularly scheduled Board meeting to be ratified.
6. The Board cannot waive a statutory requirement, or any rule that points to a statute.
