2018-2019 TECHNICIAN RENEWAL

ATTENTION ALL PIC'S, CERTIFIED PHARMACY TECHNICIANS, AND REGISTERED PHARMACY TECHNICIANS, and District Managers

The New Hampshire Board of Pharmacy office has completed all renewals that have been submitted for registered and certified pharmacy technicians. If technicians have not received their permit or have not provided it to the Pharmacist In Charge, the technician needs to call the office at 603-271-2350.

All Technician permits WILL expire on March 31, 2018 at midnight. They cannot practice after that date. It is the responsibility of the pharmacist in charge to verify their technicians status.

If a technician was certified, and has requested to be changed to a registered pharmacy technician, here are some guidelines everyone should follow:

1. A registered pharmacy technician will not have CPhT after their name on the permit.
2. The Registered Pharmacy Technician **cannot** do data entry unless they have met the criteria for data entry as stated in the Administrative Rules for Board of Pharmacy Ph800.
3. If a Registered Technician wishes to go back to a Certified Pharmacy Technician license type, they need to re-apply using the Initial Application, submitting the following documents:
 - a. Completed Initial Application in all manner, no blank spaces.
 - b. Writing in their permit number on the application after their name.
 - c. Copies of required Continuing Education credits within the last 12 months.
 - d. Copy of the National Certification Certificate.
 - e. Application fee of \$50.00 made payable to Treasurer, State of New Hampshire.
4. Registered Pharmacy technicians cannot practice as a Certified Pharmacy Technician until they **apply for and receive** a Certified Pharmacy Permit back from the Board of Pharmacy Office, showing we have issued a Certified Pharmacy Technician permit.
