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**Pharmacist Acknowledgement of Postponement of PIC Exam in NH Due to COVID-19**

Due to the current COVID-19 State of Emergency in New Hampshire, the Board of Pharmacy has postponed all in-person PIC (Pharmacist-In-Charge) Exams required per Ph 704.11 for the duration of the Declared State of Emergency.

Pharmacists who have not yet sat for and passed the NH PIC Exam, yet meet all other requirements to be a PIC in NH, will be allowed to serve as PIC at a NH pharmacy during the interim period until they can take the exam after the State of Emergency is lifted. Once the State of Emergency / Stay At Home Order is lifted by the Governor of NH, you will have 60-days to take and pass the PIC exam.

By signing below, you acknowledge you understand the above provisions, that you have thoroughly reviewed all [NH Pharmacy Laws / Rules](#), and further understand that should you be unable to take and pass the PIC exam within 60 days of the lifting of the State of Emergency / Stay At Home Order in NH, you will no longer be able to serve as a PIC in NH until such time that you are able to pass the exam as required by Ph 704.11.
