

Limited Retail Drug/Device Distributors – Reporting Changes

(Includes Public Health Clinics, Methadone Clinics, & Retail Medical Gas/Device Distributors)

NH State Law – RSA 318:51-b Licensing of Limited Retail Drug Distributors Required.

I. No person shall operate as a limited retail drug distributor, as defined in RSA 318:1, VII-a, without first having obtained a license to do so from the board. Such license shall expire annually on June 30. An application together with a reasonable fee as established by the board shall be filed annually on or before July 1.

Ph 601.05 Changes in Supporting Information. The applicant **shall notify the board, immediately,** of any changes of information from that which was submitted on the original application pursuant to Ph 601.03. **Failure to report changes shall result in the imposition of a \$25 administrative fine.** No license shall be issued until all fees and fines are paid in full.
