RE: CHAPTER Ph 1500 NEW HAMPSHIRE CONTROLLED DRUG PRESCRIPTION HEALTH AND SAFETY PROGRAM (NHPDMP): ABILITY TO PRINT NH PATIENT QUERY REPORT AND PLACE IN PATIENT MEDICAL RECORD

The Board of Pharmacy had previously issued a notification that NHPDMP information could not be printed and/or stored in a patient medical record. This notification is to reverse that notification and provide the following changes that have been adopted into rule by the NH Board of Pharmacy:

Rule Notification Change: Ph 1505.02 Prescriber and Dispenser Access.

(f) All program information, as listed in Ph 1504.01(b), to the extent that it is medical information shall be treated and protected as all protected health information.

(i) The program information may be placed in the patient medical records.

Please note that “program information” pertains to New Hampshire specific data only.

It does not include data obtained from an “interstate query”. Due to other state laws and interstate agreements to have access to other state prescription drug monitoring information, data obtained from other state monitoring reports **cannot be stored** in a patient medical record.
