VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE

Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the New Hampshire Board of Psychology ("Board"), I, Denise Leville, PhD, hereby voluntarily surrender my New Hampshire license (#1156) effective on May 31, 2019.

By voluntarily surrendering my license, I understand that:

1. I relinquish all rights and privileges to practice as a licensed psychologist in the State of New Hampshire effective on May 31, 2019.
2. I admit that this license surrender has occurred in settlement of pending disciplinary charges.
3. I admit to no violations of RSA 329-B, but recognize that the fact of my voluntary surrender will be distributed to all relevant licensing authorities and professional societies as a disciplinary action in the same manner as a final decision making specific finding of professional misconduct. I further understand that this document shall become a permanent part of my file, and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.
4. Should I again seek licensure in the State of New Hampshire, I must meet and shall bear the burden of proving compliance with all of the standards and prerequisites then required by the Board for new applicants, including professional character requirements.
5. I understand that the pending disciplinary allegations may be considered by the Board in any future licensure application I may submit in New Hampshire. I hereby specifically

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waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available as to these misconduct allegations.

6. I understand that I have the right to seek legal counsel at my own expense. I have entered into this agreement after the opportunity to consult with legal counsel and with the full understanding of the legal consequences of this Voluntary Surrender of License.
7. I voluntarily submit this surrender of license to the Board and state that no promises or representations have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
