

**NEW HAMPSHIRE REAL ESTATE COMMISSION
COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 15, 2017**

A meeting of the New Hampshire Real Estate Commission was held on Tuesday, August 15, 2017 at 8:32 a.m. at 121 South Fruit Street, Room #B119, Concord, New Hampshire 03301.

Present: Commissioners: Daniel Jones, William Barry, Paul Lipnick, Calley Milne, and John Cronin, Esq.

Also present from OPLC: Executive Director Peter Danles, Rick Wisler, Bobbie Carter, Kinsman Corthell, and Attorney Robert Lamberti. Also present were members of the public.

The August 15, 2017 Minutes are amended to include the following:

1. OTHER BUSINESS –

Chairman Jones brought up the issue of the non-reappointment of Commissioner Calley Milne. The Commissioners were informed that Governor Sununu had elected to appoint another candidate and had done so with several other board members whose Board/Commission terms had expired.

Commissioner Barry spoke during the public meeting and stated that he learned from sources within the Governors Executive Council that the decision to not reappoint Commissioner Milne was solely due to a request from the OPLC leadership. OPLC leadership disputes that it was “solely” their decision but confirmed that they did support a new nominee that they felt would work more positively with the integration of REC into the OPLC.

Chairman Jones noted that the current make up of the commission was the best he had worked with over the past 10 years, and the departure of Commissioner Milne would be a significant setback during a particularly busy time.
