3. Communications- Board Action-

a. Review and Vote on the Draft Attorney Lamberti Provided for the 300s-500s- a few minor changes were noted in the draft that Attorney Lamberti presented to the Board. The next step for this section is to do a financial impact statement. Then once the Board gets this back from JLCAR, the Board can schedule a public comments meeting. Staff will look at other Boards to see who offers outside testing and how that is worded in the rules.

c. 600- Purpose and Scope- C. Albert will be working on incorporating all the information that was supplied to him by both P. Rowell and a listing of Board requirements from a prior meeting. C. Albert will send this to Staff for her to send out to all Board members.

The 600s will be a separate proposal from the 300s- 500s.

The Board will need to vote at the next meeting if they would like a standard form with the minimum requirements for all evaluators to use.
