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A Message From The Executive Director

About the Agency

The purpose of the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) is to promote efficient professional licensing in the State of New Hampshire. Consistent with this, OPLC's mission is to create a regulatory environment favorable to workforce opportunities while protecting the public through efficient and economic support to New Hampshire's professional licensing boards. In Fiscal Year (FY) 2023, OPLC oversaw the administration of forty-six professional licensing boards; these boards, councils, and commissions (the "boards") directly regulate their professions pursuant to the powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities granted to them by individual practice acts. In addition, OPLC directly regulated seven professions, with the advice of advisory boards.

In FY 23, OPLC undertook several initiatives to meet its statutory objective of achieving efficient operations. These initiatives are detailed below.

Key Legislation

Pertinent bills enacted during FY 22 that impact the OPLC and the boards include:

- ⇒ HB 2, relative to state fees, funds, revenues, and expenditures. Pertinent to OPLC, HB 2 revises or removes the regulation by the OPLC of several of the state's occupational regulatory boards and commissions.
- ⇒ HB 109, relative to the occupational therapy practice act. HB 109 revises the statutory definitions relative to the practice of occupational therapy.
- ⇒ HB 188, relative to the duration of physical therapy. HB 188 removes the requirement that a physical therapist refer a patient to a health care provider if there is no documented improvement after 25 days of treatment.
- ⇒ HB 223, relative to prescription refills. HB 223 creates an exception to the 34-day limit on prescription refills of schedule III topical androgens if the prescription specifies it is being used for the treatment of chronic low testosterone replacement therapy.
- ⇒ HB 262, elative to laboratory testing by licensed naturopaths. HB 262 adds naturopathic doctors to the definition of "licensed medical practitioner" for health facilities authorized for laboratory testing.

Key Legislation (Continued)

- ⇒ HB 266, relative to notice and public access requirements for hybrid and virtual agency public comment hearings for rulemaking. The bill amends the administrative procedures act to insert notice and public access requirements for hybrid and virtual agency public comment hearings.
- ⇒ HB 409, relative to the organization of the office of professional licensure and certification. HB 409, as amended, reorganizes the office of professional licensure and certification.
- ⇒ HB 426, relative to the regulation of pharmacists-in-charge in pharmacies. HB 426 adjusts how pharmacy permit holders are defined.
- ⇒ HB 500, relative to prescribing opioids via telehealth medicine. The bill modifies the procedure for physicians, physician assistants and advanced practice registered nurses to prescribe certain non-opioid and opioid controlled drugs by means of telemedicine.
- ⇒ HB 594, relative to the licensure of out-of-state applicants to boards or commissions organized under the office of professional licensure and certification. HB 594 authorizes the office of professional licensure and certification to issue licenses to out-of-state applicants who are licensed in another state, if the other state's licensing requirements are substantially similar to those in New Hampshire.
- ⇒ HB 655, relative to the office of professional licensure and certification. HB 655 consolidates the administrative authority for the OPLC into a new chapter law.
- ⇒ SB 83, relative to the signature authority of an advanced practice registered nurse or certified midwife. SB 83 allows an advanced practice registered nurse or certified midwife, acting within the scope of their practice, to certify a document in the place of a physician.
- ⇒ SB 126, relative to licensure requirements for telehealth services and relative to licensure of physicians and physician's assistants treating patients incarcerated with the department of corrections. SB 126 amends the licensure requirements for telehealth services and licensure of physician and physician's assistants as applied to the treatment of individuals incarcerated within the New Hampshire department of corrections.

OPLC's FY 23 Strategic Objectives

OPLC's primary strategic goals in FY 23 were to enhance customer service, increase licensure portability, fulfill all statutory and regulatory requirements, and promote public protection. OPLC's FY 23 strategies to accomplish these objectives included the following:

- ⇒ OPLC worked with the Department of Information Technology to obtain funding under the American Rescue Plan Act to seek and obtain a new licensing portal. On January 18, 2023, Governor and Council approved a contract between DOIT and System Automation to upgrade OPLC's licensing portal. OPLC and DOIT worked diligently through the end of FY 23 to transition license types to the new solution.
- ⇒ OPLC entered into a contract with CE Broker to provide licensees and continuing education providers with a continuing education tracking solution. OPLC plans to migrate all license types to this new solution in FY 24.
- ⇒ OPLC initiated a LEAN Project to evaluate and redesign its customer service solutions. OPLC plans to implement recommendations in FY 24.
- ⇒ OPLC participated with the Council of State Governments to draft Social Work Compact model legislation to promote portability among the states. OPLC also pursued available compacts in FY 23. OPLC plans to pursue available compacts in FY 24.
- ⇒ OPLC continued to livestream board meetings for members of the public and other external stakeholders to ensure transparency of operations and increase public protection.
- ⇒ OPLC continued its work on the "Profiling Project," to inventory all board practice acts and regulations to ensure that boards and the agency are fulfilling all legal obligations. This initiative, which is essential to establishing internal controls, is likely to be completed in FY 24, along with the migration to the new licensing portal.
- ⇒ OPLC created a Website Steering Committee. The Committee obtained feedback from internal and external stakeholders and made recommendations to the Executive Leadership Team as to ways to enhance customer service through better use of OPLC's website. In FY 24, OPLC plans to redesign its website and update its content to allow for more user self-service.
- ⇒ OPLC streamlined licensing requirements and applications for all boards, developing a universal application in rules to be used by all license types. <u>See</u> Plc 300s. This universal application allows OPLC to adapt to changes in regulations in an efficient manner.

Planning for the Future

Many of the initiatives that were successful in FY 23 provide a foundation for continuous improvement of OPLC operations and acquisition of appropriate business solutions. In FY 24, plans are in place for the development and implementation of an enforcement case management system, continued development of the OPLC online web presence, the migration of all license types to the new licensing portal and continuing education tracking solution, and resources for supporting the board partnerships. OPLC will also promote portability by finalizing permanent rules required by HB 594 and streamlining the endorsement process for applicants from other jurisdictions.





Such functions include, but are not limited to:

- ⇒ Human resource functions
- ⇒ All business administration and accounting functions, including supervision of the purchase of all equipment, materials, supplies, and services; management of the agency's fleet vehicles; and, maintenance of the OPLC's equipment and consumable inventory;
- ⇒ Establishing a retention policy for the retention and disposal of records of the OPLC and the boards; and
- ⇒ Adopting, maintaining, and implementing the rules by RSA 310:6.

One of OPLC's FY 2023-2025 strategic goals is to fulfill all statutory and regulatory compliance. The Office of the Executive Director has been working diligently to establish internal controls throughout the agency to meet this strategic



Total Revenues and Expenditures



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

About the Division

The Division of Enforcement is comprised of the Compliance Bureau, the Investigations Bureau, and the Prosecution Bureau. The division began a transition during fiscal year 2023, and has undergone a process improvement review which has resulted in the implementation of new policies and procedures. One of OPLC's FY 2023-2025 strategic goals is to promote public protection and the division has begun the necessary work to meet the performance measures set forth in this, and other, strategic goals of the agency.

The Bureaus

The Compliance Bureau includes inspectors for the professions of barbering, cosmetology, and esthetics; electricians; mechanical (gas fitters and plumbers), and pharmacy. This bureau became fully staffed in fiscal year 2023. The position of chief electrical inspector was one such vacancy that was filled. Even with vacancies during the fiscal year, this bureau managed a heavy workload. Combined, the bureau completed 2,562 inspections during fiscal year 2023. In addition, all inspectors conduct investigations in response to complaints.

The Investigations Bureau includes investigative paralegals, investigators, a paralegal, and two administrative assistants. This bureau is responsible for the intake of complaints, seeking licensee responses and records, and conducting investigations through record and document requests and interviews. This bureau works with contract investigators who have expertise in their professions and investigative bodies associated with the Board of Medicine and the Board of Mental Health Practice. This bureau provides Reports of Investigation to the boards with investigative findings, conclusions, and recommendations. In fiscal year 2023, the bureau received 1,521 complaints. This is an increase over the previous fiscal year, during which 1,097 complaints were received.

The Prosecution Bureau includes three prosecutors. This bureau prepares and prosecutes cases before the boards and negotiates settlement agreements. During fiscal year 2023, this bureau handled 193 cases. They participated in 45 adjudicatory hearings which resulted in discipline in 36 cases. They also handled emergency hearings, which occur shortly after a

board emergently suspends a licensee who poses an imminent danger to the health, safety, or welfare of the public. These require a tight turnaround and the Prosecutions Bureau, in collaboration, with the other bureaus handled 29 emergency suspensions. Of those, 20 were either upheld at the emergency hearing or the licensee agreed to sign an agreement not to practice in lieu of a hearing.


Strategic Goal: Promote Public Protection

One of the items within this strategic goal is transparency in the disciplinary process. Among the performance measures for this item are informational resources for consumers and publicly available monthly statistics. During fiscal year 2023, the division worked to improve the technology, policies, and procedures necessary to better track cases and provide meaningful statistics. Achieving technological changes have proved challenging and the division continues to seek the changes necessary to meet our goal and to implement policies and procedures which mitigate the shortcomings of the current system. This has allowed the division to implement monthly board reporting as a step towards publicly available monthly statistics. The division is also reviewing all processes to ensure continued process improvement. Implementing process improvements, policies, and procedures will allow us to provide informational resources to complainants, licensees, and the general public about the complaint, investigatory, and disciplinary processes.


