



Adopted Rules for the Board of Chiropractic Examiners

Dear Licensee,

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners would like to inform you of the recently adopted rules under **Ch 500, effective February 3, 2025**. Until then, the current rules remain in effect and must be adhered to.

Summary of Key Changes:

- **Obligation to Obey:** All licensees and individuals practicing under licensure privilege are bound by the updated ethical standards, with violations constituting unprofessional conduct.
- **Definitions Added:** “Sexual Misconduct” and related conduct have been clearly defined to uphold professional behavior.
- **Standards of Conduct:**
 - Prioritize patient safety, health, and welfare.
 - Maintain honesty, integrity, and professional boundaries.
 - Refrain from discrimination, harassment, or unethical behavior.
 - Cooperate with investigations and maintain accurate patient health records.
- **Health Records Management:**
 - Records must be legible and comprehensive, including history, diagnosis, and treatment plans.
 - Retain patient records for at least seven years and ensure timely transfer of records upon request.
- **Treatment and Billing Standards:**
 - Provide transparency in treatment costs, risks, and alternatives.
 - Uphold patient confidentiality and the right to seek second opinions.
 - Refrain from financial or recruitment-related incentives.
