  - A. House Bill 2 Bill passed on 6/21/2023
  - B. House Bill 655 update Bill passed on 6/29/2023
    - Reaffirmation of NCARB applicants would be done by the office instead of the Board.
    - 2. Complaint / Hearing process does change.
    - 3. Unlicensed practice cases gives the Board the authority to hold a hearing and levy administrative fines against individuals practicing without a license.
  - C. House Bill 337 Public Meeting Notification, Pending
    - 1. Has not been signed yet, further notice of meeting and agenda to the public.
  - D. House Bill 308 Physical & Zoom Board Meeting Quorum
    - 1. Has not been signed yet, makes it easier to secure quorum.
  - E. House Bill 594 Passed on 6/29/2023
    - 1. Reciprocity, states with substantially similar licensing requirements will be granted licensure.
    - 2. This won't have a great impact on this Board because of the use of NCARB.
