A. Fast-Track Approvals

IV. Rules Review and other Legislative Topics

A. Legislative update if necessary - OPLC Board Counsel

Shane Goulet, Board Counsel, provided the following legislative update: HB655: This bill had not been edited much since the Board last discussed it, and had quickly been recommended as "ought to pass", and would be going before full Senate. Shane highlighted some of the changes that were proposed, which included changes to "fast-track" licensure, changes to the issuing authority for licensing, changes to the complaint/investigation process, and changes to reciprocity. These items have been previously discussed.

HB2: Shane explained that this bill had largely been stripped, but he suspected there may be some last minute changes as the legislative season wound down. The abolishment of the Allied Health Board of Directors is still in HB2.

B. Ath 403.05 and Ath 406.03 - Final proposal (vote needed)

Motion:

Approve the Final Proposal for Ath 403.05 and Ath 406.03 as submitted.
