BOARD OF BARBERING, COSMETOLOGY & ESTHETICS
QUESTIONNAIRE FOR APPLICANTS AND LICENSEES

Pursuant to Bar 301.01(b)(5), this questionnaire must be completed with your application for initial or renewal registration or licensure.

(b)(5)a. Have you ever been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor, **other than a traffic violation**, which has not been annulled by a court? **YES** **NO**

(i) A Court-provided copy of the charge(s), conviction(s), penalties imposed, and a statement created by the applicant relative to the charges;

(iii) If you have completed probation or parole, a letter indicating you have met all the requirements and is no longer on parole or probation.
