**MARGIN ORDER ON EMERGENCY
SUSPENSION HEARING – 08/28/23**

I. CASE SUMMARY/PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

On or about 08/21/2023, the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification, Division of Enforcement (“OPLC Enforcement”) filed a *Verified Petition for Emergency Temporary Suspension of Licensure Pursuant to RSA 310:12, IV and N.H. Code Admin.R. Title Plc 206.07* pertaining to Ashley Williams, Pharmacy Technician (“Licensee”). On 08/21/23, the Board voted to suspend the Licensee’s privilege to practice in New Hampshire on an emergency basis pursuant RSA 310:12, IV and N.H. Code Admin. R., Title Plc 206.07 (“Plc”) (“Rules”). The Board held a hearing on 08/28/23 to determine whether the Licensee presented an imminent threat to public health, safety, or welfare such that her license should remain emergently suspended pending a full investigation and possible final disciplinary action. This Marginal Order On Emergency Suspension Hearing follows.

II. ORDER:

Pursuant to RSA 310:12, IV and Plc Rule 206.07, the Board and Presiding Officer hereby immediately lift the emergency suspension of Ashley William’s registration as a New Hampshire Pharmacy Technician. A full narrative order shall follow.
