  of the above captioned complaints and in compliance with sentencing conditions
  imposed in the matter of State v. John Alan Zegar, Case No. 449-2022-CR-01419,
  Dist. Div. R. 8 (09/11/2023).
- 3. I admit to no violations of any State statutes, rules, or ethical provision, but recognize that the fact that my *Voluntary Surrender of License* will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action.

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- 4. This Voluntary Surrender of License shall be distributed to all relevant licensing authorities and professional societies in the same manner as a final decisionmaking specific finding of professional misconduct.
- 5. This *Voluntary Surrender of License* shall become a permanent part of my file and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.

In the event I submit an application for licensure under RSA 328-A, I understand that the above reference pending misconduct allegations shall be addressed at a Show Cause Hearing in any future licensure application process before the Board at which I shall have the burden of proof. These misconduct allegations may then form the basis for the Board to deny any such application. I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available as to these misconduct allegations, including but not limited to, those contained in RSA 332-G:8 and 9.
- 7. I voluntarily submit this *Voluntary Surrender of License* to the Board and state that no promises or representation have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
- 8. I have had the opportunity to seek and obtain the advice of an attorney of my choosing in connection with my decision to sign this *Voluntary Surrender of License*.
- I am not under the influence of any substance that would impair my judgment and am otherwise of sound mind at the time I sign this Voluntary Surrender of License.
