1. MINUTES

A. Approval of Public Minutes from September 25, 2023

On a motion by Ryan Fennelly and seconded by Mike Dyer the Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes from September 25, 2023, as submitted.

On a motion by Ryan Fennelly and seconded by Kimberly McBrine the Commission voted to unanimously approve the initial proposal draft of rules BOX 300, 400, 500, 600, 700, 800.
