3. Cost and benefits of the proposed rule(s):

The proposed rules establish dental license revocation, suspensions and sanctions to licensees who violate the laws and rules governing the dental profession. The proposed rules impose new fines and penalties, which could increase revenue to the OPLC Fund by an indeterminable amount as well as increase costs to certain state citizens to the extent they violate the law and rules, and a penalty is imposed. The Board of Dental Examiners is unable to estimate the amount of new penalties that would be collected by violation of the rules and laws.
