The Electricians Board proposed amendment to Elec 400 are to readopt, readopt with amendment, and repeal specific sections as follows:

Elec 401.01 describs renewal of licenses and is being readopted with amendment to state that all licenses issued by the board has expire 2 years from the date of issuance and direct applications to the PLC rules to find where the fees are listed;

Elec 401.02 through 401.06 describes the renewal cycle and fees for master electricians, journeyman electricians, apprentice identification care and high/medium voltage electricians and is being repealed;

Elec 401.02 describe the renewal of the identification card renumber as Elec 401.02 and is being readopted with amendment to set the renewal of an identification card for the apprentice and trainee day as the last day of the month 1 year from the date of renewal;
