I. Call To Order

Board Chair Chris Mulleavey opened the Board meeting at 9:01 am.

II. Review of Public Minutes from October 20, 2023 -

The Board reviewed the public minutes from October 20, 2023. Board Member Paul Mullin made a motion to approve the minutes from October 20, 2023. Board Member David Gill seconded the motion. The motion passed with a roll call vote. Board Member Shawn G. Bergeron abstained from the vote.

III. Public Appearances:

A. Bethany Cottrell, Director of Licensing and Administration. Bethany attended the meeting for the Board Engineers to explain the HB 594 to the Board. HB 594 is drafting rules to implement this House Bill. The Bill will allow individuals with the same requirements or substantially similar as to New Hampshire to be licensed in the State of New Hampshire as long as they are in good standing with the State, they are currently licensed.

B. Shawn G. Bergeron, Sr. with Bergeron Technical Services LLC. New Board Member. Board Chair Chris Mulleavey introduced Mr. Bergeron to the Board. Mr. Bergeron is filling the Board Member position as a public member.

Bethany Cottrell, Director of Licensing and Administration discussed with the Board on the requirements of licensure by reciprocity/endorsement that only states that meet the same requirements of NH. The Board noted they would like to continue to review the applications for exam.
