## **NEW BUSINESS**

# A. Rule/Statue Clarification Request.

#### 1. Electro-Body Therapy

Rahkiya Medley-Board Counsel addressed the board and advised that this function falls under the scope of other licensed professions therefore not within scope for licensed Massage Therapists. On a motion by Susan Pracsch and seconded by Julie Smith the board voted that a licensed Massage Therapist cannot charge for this service to the public.

#### 2. Polarity and Cranial Therapy

The board recommended that this function can be performed by licensed Massage Therapists.

#### **PENDING LEGISLATION**

#### A. HB341 - Relative to Massage Therapy

Board Counsel Rahkiya Medley let the board know that this bill will not be moving forward by a 11-9 vote. This bill would not be possible for OPLC to oversee.

## **B. SB212 - Relative to Massage Therapy**

Board Counsel Rahkiya Medley updated the board that she will follow up with the board of where this stands after the hearing next Wednesday April 26<sup>th</sup>.
