- Letter sent directly to the Board of Medicine by [email](#) from program director. The letter **must** include the following:
 - Official letterhead
 - Date
 - Signature of program director
 - Name of the ACGME or AOA accredited program, including the ACGME/AOA ID number
 - Beginning date and end date of program
- Verification of licensure, if applicant is license in another state
- USMLE exam scores received directly from the NBME
- ECFMG, if applicable

Requirements for Current Licensed Residents:

Complete if you wish to extend the duration of your training license.

- Letter sent directly to the Board of Medicine by email from program director. The letter **must** include the following:
 - Official letterhead
 - Date
 - Signature of program director
 - New program end date
