The State of New Hampshire, Office of Professional Licensure and Certification, Division of Enforcement has a full-time vacancy for an Electrical Inspector.

Summary:

To monitor and inspect electrical work to assure licensing requirements and the National Electrical Code are met. Investigation of complaints concerning electrical work as directed by the Electricians' Board, Chief Electrical Inspector or the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification against licensed and unlicensed individuals to verify compliance with the Electricians' Board Administrative Rules and the National Electrical Code.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Education: High School diploma or High School equivalency, plus completion of a four-year apprenticeship program as an electrician or two years of technical college education with specialization in the area of electricity.

Experience: Five years' experience as a licensed Master electrician, at least three of which must have been in a supervisory position concerned with interpretations of the National Electrical Code.

License/Certification: Must hold a valid Master Electrician's license issued by the State of New Hampshire and a valid New Hampshire driver's license.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be available for overtime work on short notice and emergency work at times other than normal business hours based on workload and critical need. Criminal history record check completed by the State of New Hampshire State Police is required.

RECOMMENDED WORK TRAITS:

Thorough knowledge of the Electrical Code and of common electrical practices. Considerable knowledge of installation, repair,

alteration and maintenance of electrical conductors, fittings, devices and fixtures for heating, lighting, or power purposes. Thorough knowledge of proper workmanship in installations, electrical apparatus, wire devices and raceways. Ability to investigate electrical installations and prepare reports and recommendations. Ability to understand, interpret and apply rules and codes of the Electricians' Board. Ability to maintain records, answer correspondence and prepare reports. Ability to establish and maintain harmonious relationships with electricians, electrical contractors, union personnel and the general public as relates to the operation and responsibility of the Electricians' Board. Must be willing to maintain appearance appropriate to assigned duties and responsibilities as determined by the agency appointing authority.

Responsibilities:

Completes inspection reports on work progress to record compliance with the National Electrical Code.

Develops questions for and assists in administration of licensing examinations in order to provide technical assistance to the Chief Electrical Inspector and Electricians' Board.

Investigates complaints as directed by the Chief Electrical Inspector against licensed and unlicensed individuals.

Summarizes information of charges of fraud, gross negligence, incompetence or misconduct and make periodic court appearances relative to investigation of RSA 319-C, the Electricians' Law. Prepares reports to maintain records of current electricians' licenses.

Makes recommendations to the Chief Electrical Inspector on the suspension or revocation of electricians' licenses and on consent or settlement agreements based upon information obtained during an investigation.

Periodically assists in the investigation of electrically related fires in order to provide technical assistance, as requested.

Maintains records detailing his/her daily activities.

Periodically assists local code enforcement officials with inspections of electrical installations performed by licensed electricians and interpretations of the National Electrical Code and related administrative rules.

Meets with licensees, electrical contractors and concerned public groups for the purpose of explaining licensing requirements, the procedures for administration of electricians' examinations and the application of the National Electrical Code and related administrative rules.
