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Concord, N.H. –Today, Executive Director Courtney announces that Daniel K. Twombly, Principal Broker License #056052, has signed a Preliminary Agreement Not to Practice, effective March 21, 2023, pending further investigation.

On Saturday, March 11, 2023, the Real Estate Commission suspended Daniel K. Twombly's, Principal Broker License #056052, at an Emergency Meeting of the Commission held to specifically address a complaint alleging that Mr. Twombly misappropriated funds held in an escrow account over which he exercised custody and control.

The Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC), on behalf of the Real Estate Commission, is actively investigating and cooperating with all agencies involved in this matter. OPLC is aware that licensed Real Estate Salespersons may have pending contracts impacted by this suspension. OPLC is deferring collection of the license amendment fee associated with affected licensee's designation of a replacement Principal Broker.
