DECISION

This matter came before the Board of Manufactured Housing (hereinafter referred to as the Board) on the complaint of Anne Curran (hereinafter referred to as the Complainants) against Maple Leaf MHP (hereinafter referred to as the Respondent).

At the March 8, 2019 meeting, the Board requested a letter be sent to the Complainant requiring a completed Complaint Form and filing fee to be received no later than March 25, 2019. The Complainant responded with a letter but submitted no Complaint Form or fee. In her letter, the Complainant also indicated that she would not be attending any hearing before the Board, and she did not attend on June 7, 2019.

Accordingly, the Board UNANIMOUSLY finds and rules that the matter is dismissed based on the Complainant's failure to comply with Man 203.01(c)(1) requiring the filing of a Complaint and payment of a filing fee.

Man 211.01 Motions for rehearing, reconsideration or clarification or other such post-hearing motions shall be filed within 30 days of the date of the Board's order or decision. Filing a rehearing motion shall be a prerequisite to appealing to the superior court in accordance with RSA 204-A:28, II.
