PRELIMINARY AGREEMENT FOR PRACTICE RESTRICTIONS

The New Hampshire Board of Medicine ("NH Board") granted Michael J. O'Connell, M.D. ("Respondent"), a State of New Hampshire license to practice medicine on August 5, 1987. Respondent holds license number 7690.

O'Connell enters into a Preliminary Agreement with the NH Board as follows:

1. Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the Board, I, Michael J. O'Connell, M.D., hereby voluntarily agree not to practice medicine, not to write prescriptions, and not to treat or see patients in the State of New Hampshire until such time as the Board approves my return to practice.

2. I admit to no violations of RSA Chapter 329 or any other laws, statutes, regulations or ethical codes.

3. Understanding that these restrictions shall remain until further order of the Board, I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available as to the pending misconduct allegations.


4. I further understand that this document shall become a permanent part of my file, and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.
