RULING

This matter came on for hearing before the Board of Manufactured Housing (hereinafter referred to as the Board) on the motion for rehearing of Thomas Moughan (hereinafter referred to as the Complainant) against Ann Guttadauro, as General Manager and Lamplighter Mobile Home Park, LP (hereinafter collectively referred to as the Respondent) alleging the Respondent's conduct to be in violation of RSA 205-A:2, X (a), (b), (c) and RSA 205-A:2, XI. The Petitioner appeared pro se. Attorney Donald R. Routhier appeared for the Respondent. After careful consideration of the arguments presented, which the board permitted for over an hour, the board finds and unanimously rules that the Complainant failed to demonstrate the board's decision is unlawful, unjust or unreasonable. While the motion identifies purported errors of fact and reasoning the board notes that the Complainant simply restated the gravamen of his complaint which the board had rejected and he failed to identify errors of law. The board concludes that irregularities in the proceedings alleged by the Complainant, if error, amounted to harmless error. The board therefore concludes that the Complainant failed to demonstrate that the decision is illegal with respect to jurisdiction [despite being named the Respondent Lamplighter Mobile Home Park, LP is considered to be the proper party and not the named General Manager (see RSA 205-A:27. IV.(a))], authority, or observance of law, an abuse of discretion or arbitrary, unreasonable or capricious. Accordingly the motion for rehearing is unanimously voted: Denied.
