ORDER APPROVING ASSENTED TO EMERGENCY MOTION FOR A ONE MONTH EXTENSION OF MEDICAL LICENSE

On December 14, 2016, a Consent Order was issued in the matter of Greg Thompson, M.D. ("Dr. Thompson"). The Consent Order suspended Dr. Thompson's license to practice medicine for the period of one (1) year, beginning sixty (60) days after the effective date of the Consent Order, or February 12, 2017. The Consent Order has a provision that Dr. Thompson may petition the Board to extend this period if he is unable to appropriately transfer all patients, providing a detailed explanation as to why an extension is necessary and what steps he has taken to assist patients.

Now before the Board is an Assented to Emergency Motion for a One Month Extension of Medical License ("Motion") submitted by Michael J. Iacopino, Esq., counsel for Dr. Thompson, dated February 14, 2017. The Motion indicates that Dr. Thompson had written refillable prescriptions for approximately 24 patients, which he discovered on February 10, 2017, would not be honored by pharmacies as Dr. Thompson's license would have been surrendered and, therefore, the prescriptions would not be fillable. Attorney Iacopino goes on to say that the affected patients would not be able to receive their prescriptions, including both Suboxone and general psychiatry medications during this period of time necessitating an emergency request to the Board to extend Dr. Thompson's medical license for an addition period of one month.

The Presiding Officer in this matter approved the Parties' Motion for a one month extension of medical license in order to facilitate the refilling of these prescriptions for the aforementioned patients, however, Dr. Thompson will provide NO further treatment, including the issuance of any prescriptions, to these or any other patients during the 30-day extension.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the Assented to Emergency Motion for a One Month Extension of Medical License in this matter is GRANTED; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Thompson will provide NO further treatment, including the issuance of any prescriptions, to the aforementioned patients, or any other patients, during the 30-day extension; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the one year suspension shall begin 30 days from the effective date of this Order, or midnight on March 16, 2017.
