PRELIMINARY AGREEMENT NOT TO PRACTICE

The New Hampshire Board of Medicine (“Board”) granted Wendy Pavnick (“Respondent”), a State of New Hampshire license to practice as a physician assistant on November 6, 2002. Respondent holds license number 0453.

Respondent enters into a *Preliminary Agreement Not to Practice* with the Board as follows:

Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the Board, I, Wendy Pavnick, PA, hereby voluntarily agree not to practice medicine, which includes, but is not limited to, writing prescriptions, examining/seeing patients, diagnosing patients, and treating patients, effective upon signing this document and/or until further order of the Board.

1. I admit to no violations of any statutes, including RSA 329:17, VI or any administrative rules or ethics provisions adopted by the Board.

2. Understanding that these restrictions shall remain until further order of the Board, I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available, including, but not limited to, those based on RSA 332-G:8 and 9. I also waive any potential issues regarding a lack of a speedy hearing or spoliation of the evidence.

3. In the event that I apply for renewal of my license while this agreement is in effect, I voluntarily agree to waive any statutory or administrative time deadlines regarding the Board’s final action on any license renewal application I submit. I understand that by waiving

such deadlines, the Board's final action on any license renewal application I submit will automatically be deferred until after the disposition of this Board matter and that my license will not expire while this *Preliminary Agreement* is in effect.

4. I voluntarily enter into this agreement with the Board and state that no promises or representations have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.

5. I have had the opportunity to seek and obtain the advice of an attorney of my choosing in connection with my decision to sign this document.

6. I am of sound mind and not under the influence of any substance that would impair my judgment at the time I sign this document.
